# How To Draw Ponies



1. Sketch in the basic lines of your pony's head and neck



2. Add more detail to the chin, cheekbone, ears, and neck. Sketch in the eye



3. Add detail to the eye, the mouth, and the nose.

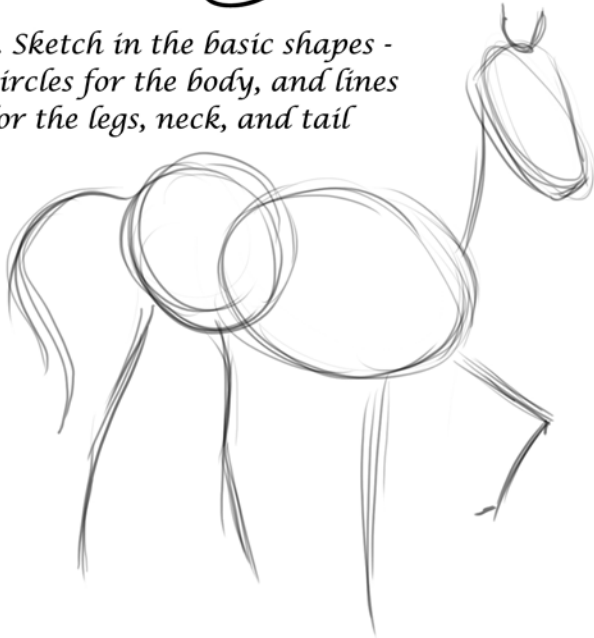


4. Finally, sketch in the mane, and add some color or shading.

# How To Draw Ponies

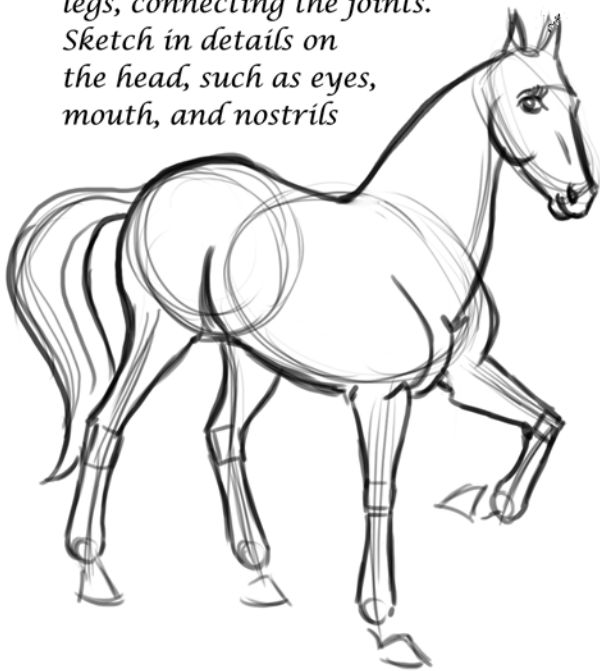
1. Sketch in the basic shapes - circles for the body, and lines for the legs, neck, and tail



2. Draw in the lines for the back, neck, belly, and chest. Also sketch the joints for the legs



3. Fill in the body and legs, connecting the joints. Sketch in details on the head, such as eyes, mouth, and nostrils



4. Finish your pony drawing by sketching in details like the mane and tail. Add some shading.
